

SO CAL CLAY-BUSTERS RULES AND REGULATIONS

Effective September 1, 2024

1. Always obey all Range Safety Officer's commands without exception, hesitation, or argument.
2. Always keep your firearm pointed in a safe direction.
3. All firearms to remain unloaded with actions open until ready to shoot.
4. Always keep finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
5. Eye and ear protection must be worn by all individuals, shooting or otherwise, on the range side of the fence.
6. Only load a firearm while at the firing position.
7. Unload and clear the firearm before moving away from or between firing positions. It is not permissible to move from firing position to firing position with a loaded firearm.
8. Only one (1) shotgun shell is to be loaded into a shotgun before any target is shot for Singles shooting.
9. Two (2) shotgun shells may be loaded into a shotgun if a Doubles event is being shot.
10. Only one shotgun, on a field, may be loaded and ready to fire at any time.
11. Do not load, prepare to shoot, or shoot from any station where a cone is on the traphouse.
12. Spectators are not allowed on the firing line, and must wait at the back of the field at the benches or behind the fence.
13. All ammo must be 7-1/2, 8, or 9 shot, 1300 fps maximum. Only lead shot is permitted.
14. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages of any kind are allowed on the trap field. Anyone suspected of consuming alcoholic beverages prior to shooting will not be allowed to participate in any So Cal Clay-Busters event that day, and will be asked to leave the event.
15. Anyone suspected of being under the influence of any substance, whether legal or not, prior to shooting will not be allowed to participate in any So Cal Clay-Busters event that day, and will be asked to leave the event.
16. All participants must be twenty-one (21) years of age or older, or accompanied by their parent.
